As a national centre for judicial archives, it preserves these records while making them accessible for education, research, and public engagement, thereby promoting transparency and awareness of the judicial system.

This project accomplished by **Clarity Consulting** is distinguished by its extensive use of advanced audio-visual technologies and immersive media. **Virtual Reality (VR)** and **Augmented Reality (AR)** installations recreate courtroom environments, allowing visitors to experience simulated proceedings and interact with legal scenarios. These systems enable users to ask law-related questions within the experience, encouraging a deeper understanding of legal processes, citizen rights, and the functioning of the judiciary.

Large-format projections, interactive digital exhibits, synchronised soundscapes, and thoughtfully designed theatrical lighting work together to create a compelling narrative journey. Together, these elements transform complex judicial concepts into intuitive, engaging experiences, making the museum both educational and highly immersive for diverse audiences.



### **AV Display Of The Constitution**

**Showcasing the constitution of the country as the centre piece that ties everything together in the museum, the preamble, along with historical documents, and other materials related to the development and interpretation of the constitution**

- **A large book display representing the constitution placed in the centre of the atrium with projection mapping. The installation extending across the 3 levels**
- **Layered display with showcases and panels displaying the constitution and other artefacts/objects/photos/documents, etc.**
- **A 3D text-based installation of the preamble to the constitution**
- **A hologram of Ambedkar delivering the speech on drafting the Constitution of India**



**AV Recreation of the Court's Infrastructural Evolution**  
 The evolution of the Supreme Court through a short AV recreating the growth through a virtual model. Also displaying in this section, is a physical architectural model for visitors who spend more time looking at the details

- A Large Digital Screen playing AV




**Showcasing the use of technology in Judiciary - Special focus – Supreme Court**

- Portraits of Judges presently in Court Rooms and other areas of the building
- Notable women judge of the Supreme Court and other notable women in legal profession
- A dynamic & interactive photo-gallery of other the notable personalities using sliding screen interactive exhibit complemented with a few touchscreens for detailed content on the personalities



**Audio and visual display room to run documentaries and movies based on the judiciary/legal systems. Full-length screens for display/projection of visuals and appropriate seating**
